Please let the office know if there are any medical concerns (anaphylaxis, epilepsy, diabetes, etc.) that teachers and/or office staff should be aware of, and specific instructions on what to do in case of any incidents. We have Anaphylaxis Emergency Plan forms in the office for those with lifethreatening allergies. We also suggest that, if you are not remaining in the school with your child, you advise staff of what "plan of action" is required if there is a potential incident that requires medical attention.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

Coyote Sightings Parents, please BEWARE, our area is often a habitat for coyotes. At the time of this writing, we had not seen any in our immediate area but Burlington seems to be seeing more of these creatures. Please ensure you either walk your child in/out of the school, make sure they arrive safely through the doors, or ensure they do not go outside unattended.

No fathers (or brothers) in the girls' dressing room. Please note that fathers (or brothers) are not allowed in the girls' dressing room. If you need to assist your daughter(s) with getting dressed for dance, please do so in the Preschool Room or the washroom situated within the Preschool Room.

For the safety of your children, please arrange to meet your children inside after dark rather than in the parking lot as we are in an isolated area. Children should not be outside in the dark by themselves at any time. Also, it's always prudent to remind your children of the dangers of approaching someone they don't know.

Please respect our office space. It becomes very difficult for people to enter the office when they have to tip-toe over children, toys and food. For your children's safety please be considerate and kindly use the Preschool Room downstairs for such activities.

Please put your *child's name in all personal belongings* (dance shoes, clothing, winter boots, BDA bags, etc.). This will assist you in recovering lost items.

<u>Absolutely no food</u> allowed in the office area. Kindly use the Preschool Room downstairs for any food consumption, including snacks.

BDA is a *peanut/nut-free facility*. Please do not bring anything into the building that "may contain nuts or peanuts".

For those with younger children, we have a *change table available* in the downstairs Preschool Room washroom for diaper changes. Please dispose of diapers into a plastic bag before putting into our garbage.

In the event of *poor weather*, *school closure notification will be available* via e-mail, Facebook, or Instagram. Classes missed due to inclement weather cannot be made up.

If a student misses classes due to illness, they may be able to make them up during the season. Please check with the office for alternate classes.

Beware of parking in cul-de-sac and on the street For the safety of the children, please be **extra careful** when exiting the lot. The cul-de-sac should be used as a 'drop off' and 'pick up' area ONLY.

If you park at Fairview Glen next to the school, you will be towed! Please do not use their parking lot

The lower level Preschool room, in addition to the Lower Level *waiting room* may be used by parents and students as an additional "Waiting Room" during classes, as our office can become congested, especially on Thursdays and Saturdays.

Please refrain from opening up the cupboards in our Preschool Room. <u>The cupboards and toys belong to the Preschool</u>. Please do not help yourselves with items in the cupboards or any of the toys.
